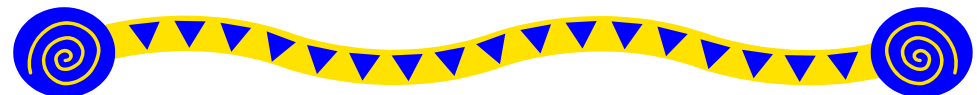


We will have two Open Houses on

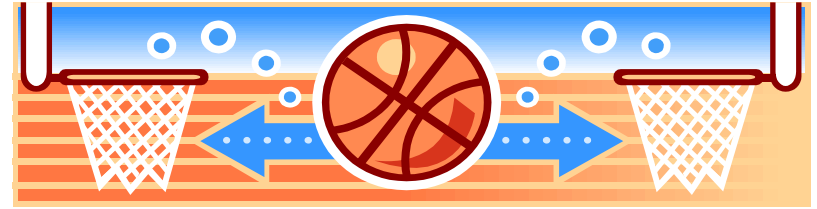
