WCA is a small, private, Christian school located in the beautiful lakes region of southern Maine. Windham is a very safe, small town listed as one of Maine's fastest growing communities. It is a 40 minute drive to Portland, Maine's largest city and cultural hub; a 40 minute drive to the Atlantic Ocean; and a 2 hour ride from Boston, Massachusetts. There are also ample locations to ski, hike, swim, boat, and camp as well as have a varied cultural experience. The closest airport is Portland International Airport (PWM) approximately 40 minutes from the school.

School

Windham Christian Academy is a college preparatory school founded in 1981. We have a desirable student to teacher ratio of 5:1. Our competent and experienced Christian staff strives to promote a close and positive family atmosphere. We emphasize character building and encourage spiritual and academic growth in all of our students. Unique to our school is our wood-working class which has constructed

everything from boats to ukuleles; our community service emphasizing philanthropy and team building; and our sports team where all players have a chance to participate. Uniforms are not required though there is a dress code emphasizing modesty.

Enrollment

There are fifteen student in the high school for the 2018-2019 school year with 2 full-time faculty members and 5 part-time faculty members. WCA is a Pre-K through 12th school. In total, the school has an enrollment of 65. A total of 249 students have graduated from WCA. The 2018-2019 school year begins September 4, 2018 and ends June 12, 2019. WCA does have open enrollment and will accept students at any time.

Curriculum

The academic program focuses on a balance of core requirement classes and enrichment classes. All classes are taught and analyzed from a biblical worldview where discussion and analysis is encouraged. Core classes include: Humanities, combining literature, social studies, writing, and English grammar; Mathematics, from algebra through Advanced Math; Sciences, including Physics, Earth Science, Chemistry, and Biology; Foreign Language, with a choice of either Latin or Spanish; and Bible. Enrichment classes include: music, where students have a choice between instrumental

band or chorus in the form of our worship team; art classes including woodworking and fine arts; and physical education. There is also the opportunity to join our drama program resulting in a school play. Currently, ESL classes are not available however international students may be in a separate English class to accommodate their needs. The school does offer tutoring for an extra fee.

Seniors and second semester juniors are allowed to participate in the St. Joseph's College Early Scholar's Program. Through this unique program, students take classes at a collegiate level ensuring that when they graduate high school, they have completed 12 credits in college courses.

Graduation Requirements

24 credits are required to graduate from WCA. All students must take Bible (4), English (4), Social Studies (4), Math (4), Foreign Language (2), Science (3), Computer (1), Fine Arts (1), Physical Education (1), and electives. In addition to credits earned, students must participate in a designated amount of community service during their 9th-12th grades in their church, community, missions and school.

Higher Education and Testing

80% of the students graduating between 2014 and 2017 have attended or will attend college. An average of students' PSAT scores is 998.5.
