1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative inerrant word of God (II Timothy 3:15; II Peter 1:21).
2. We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Genesis 1:1; Matthew 28:19; John 10:30).
3. We believe in the deity of Christ (John 10:33); His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:23; Luke 1:35); His sinless life (Hebrew 4:15, 7:26); His miracles (John 2:11); His vicarious and atoning death (I Corinthians 15:3; Ephesians 1:7; Hebrews 2:9); His resurrection (John 11:25; I Corinthians 15:4); His Ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19); the gathering together of the saints known as the Rapture (I Thess. 4:16-18); and His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11; Revelation 19:11).
4. We believe in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature, and that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ and that only by God's grace and through faith alone are we saved (John 3:16-19, 5:24; Romans 3:23, 5:8-9; Ephesians 2:8-10; Titus 3:5).

2021-2022 FULL TIME STUDENT TUITION RATES

Registration: *All registration fees are non-refundable.*

New Registration Fee (New Students): \$120 Due upon acceptance

Re-registration Fee (Returning Students): \$60 if paid before March 31, \$120 thereafter

Curriculum Fee: Curriculum includes textbooks, as well as arts and science fees. Curriculum fees are due on or before August 1st. Curriculum fees paid after August 10th will be charged a late fee of \$25. Families applying after August 1st will have two weeks to get curriculum fees in. *All curriculum fees are non-refundable and are not eligible for discounts.*

PreK-Kindergarten	\$200 per student
1st-6th Grade	\$370 per student
7th-8th Grade	\$445 per student
9th-12th Grade	\$475 per student

Tuition: Tuition runs September-June and is due on the first of the month. Payments received after the 10th will be charge a late fee of \$25.

PreK Program (3 year old)	\$1,900 = \$190 month
PreK Program (4 year old)	\$2,750 = \$275 month
Kindergarten	\$3,950 = \$395 month
1st-6th Grade	\$4,950 = \$495 month
7th-12th Grade	\$5,150 = \$515 month

Any additional costs throughout the year are in programs where participation is optional such as athletics, our hot lunch program, and field trips.

Also note that our tuition does not cover all the costs associated with running a school. Therefore, in an effort to keep tuition low, we expect that parents participate in fundraisers throughout the year including, but not limited to,

- Wreath Sales
- Craft Fair
- Mystery Dessert Theatre
- CLYNK Challenge

Scholarships and Aid Available

Families may apply for ONE of the following options:

Windham Assembly of God Membership Scholarship: 25% off tuition to tithing members of Windham Assembly of God. Members are those who are listed on the membership list and remain in good standing with the church for the duration of the school year for scholarship to apply.

Family Scholarship: First child pays full price. Each additional student gets a 5% discount off of tuition.

WCA Ministerial Scholarship: 25% off tuition to children of parents in full time ministry. Scholarship handed out at the discretion of the administration.

Staff Scholarship: Staff members receive a discount off tuition for children.

Early Payment Scholarship: Tuition paid in full on or before September 1st receives a 5% discount. *(This may be combined with one other scholarship, if applicable.)*

WCA Tuition Aid Program: Families who are unsure if they can cover the cost of a Christian education may apply for Tuition Aid. There is an application fee of \$30 for a third party to assess what payments a family may reasonably be able to make. That number is then brought back to the family for them to make an informed decision if their family is willing to cover the adjusted tuition cost. PreK and Kindergarten students are not eligible for tuition aid unless there are other full-time students in the family attending the Academy. *For more information or an application, please contact the school office. Applications will be accepted from March 1-March 31.*

BONUS:

Referral Credit: As a thank you for referring students, WCA will issue a \$300 credit towards your tuition balance for each new student you refer who enrolls and attends the academy. See the office for details.
